ACCESS TO HEALTH PROGRAMS

benefiting 33,279 residents

96% of program participants believe they have adopted healthier behaviors and have a brighter outlook on life.



EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

benefiting 376 4 & 5 year olds

76% of children evaluated are achieving developmental milestones that will help them build a successful academic career.



FINANCIAL STABILITY & BASIC NEEDS

benefiting 28,696 residents

77% of residents accessing financial services have a better understanding of their finances.



YOUTH SUCCESS

benefiting 3,204 students

88% of students who receive tutoring services during or after school believe they have better work ethic or communication, problem-solving, teamwork and time management skills.



READING BUDDIES PROGRAM


benefiting 4,000 students

75% of 1st and 2nd graders participating in the program are reading at or above grade level proficiency standards.

COVID-19 Relief & Recovery

IN MARCH 2020, THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN NEED OF VITAL, BASIC SERVICES SKYROCKETED. WITH YOUR HELP, UNITED WAY OF PORTER COUNTY:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Connected 19,100+ residents to financial and food resources, many of whom had never needed assistance before.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provided 24,300+ masks and other protection equipment to first responders, healthcare workers and frontline employees to keep them safe while serving.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mobilized 775+ volunteers to effectively support COVID relief efforts, including critical food delivery to seniors. Gathered more than 200 key nonprofits, businesses and government agencies to connect and communicate the current and anticipated needs to prepare for recovery. Distributed more than \$1.2 million dollars to support United Way network activities and sustain basic services between March and June.

Our COVID recovery efforts will continue well into the fall of 2021, as we implement mortgage assistance programs, network partner grants and new needs initiatives to help families stabilize.
