- Communicate with other school staff, parents, and students regarding progress or barriers to success for students.
- Attend required training
- Maintain student confidentiality
- Collaborate with classroom teachers to meet the needs of all students
- Proactively identify students in need of support
- Other duties to meet the academic and/or social-emotional needs of the students served.

## **Candidate preferred qualification:**

- Some college level course work preferred.
- Computer related skills and ability to serve using computer assisted learning software.
- Pass Drug Test. Pass Background/Fingerprint Clearance (if on file with school system, a copy must by provided to CISLC Administrative office).
- Ability to serve with staff and families from diverse backgrounds and experiences.
- Knowledge of the structure and content of the English language including the meaning and spelling of words, rules of composition, and grammar.
- Have the ability to serve in recreational and outdoor settings with youth of various ages.
- Knowledge in basic level and upper level math; and algebraic concepts.
- Previous experience serving adolescents in academic enrichment and recreational programs.
